

Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Development Plan Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 20 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, this Statement hereby gives notice that on 13th September 2021 the London Borough of Camden made (adopted) the Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Plan as a Development Plan Document for the designated neighbourhood area.

The Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Area was formally designated by Camden Council on 5 September 2014.

This Statement confirms that the Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Plan has met the statutory requirements and forms part of the Council's Development Plan for the designated area. Development proposals located within the designated area will be determined therefore in accordance with the Development Plan (including the Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Plan) unless material considerations indicate otherwise.
