 - (v) HARRISON STREET (Zone CA-D): north side, adjacent to Great Croft (5.2 metres);
 - (vi) ROCHESTER ROAD (Zone CA-G): north-east side, outside Nos.

17 to 22 Rochester Road (5.2 metres);

- (vii) DENNING ROAD (Zone CA-H): south side, outside Nos. 42 and 44 Denning Road (5.2 metres);
- (viii) ELDON GROVE (Zone CA-H): south-west side, outside No. 9 Eldon Grove (6 metres of double yellow lines);

- (c) to remove 7.2 metres of permit holders parking space in OSENEY CRESCENT (Zone CA-M): north side, opposite No. 69 Oseney Crescent, extend the adjacent cycle parking place by 2 metres and provide 5.2 metres single yellow line 'controlled hours' waiting restrictions in order to install pedal cycle hangars;

- (d) to remove a disabled persons' parking place and replace it with resident permit holders' parking space in Heath Hurst Road, the north-east side, outside No. 36 Heath Hurst Road.

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There is a growing demand from residents living in high density dwellings, with limited space for sheltered and secure cycle parking within their properties.

A lack of secure cycle hangar storage facilities is currently a barrier to people to cycle.

A key objective of the Camden Transport Strategy is to improve cycling facilities for those both living, visiting and working in Camden.

The Council believes the introduction of secure cycle hangar parking facilities would encourage the use of cycling within the borough especially in locations where high density dwellings are present.

As part of the Council's 'safe and healthy streets' programme of cycling and walking highway improvement measures, this Order amends the provisions of the Camden (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Civil Enforcement Area) Traffic Order 2012, so as to provide lengths of 'single yellow line' waiting restrictions at locations where cycle hangars are to be provided, in the London Borough of Camden.
